Kate Hamill's *Holmes and Watson* is a 'fast femme farce' to kick off 2025

Olympia, WA – December 30, 2024 – Harlequin Productions presents *Ms. Holmes and Ms. Watson* – *Apt. 2B* by Kate Hamill, January 24 – February 9, 2025, at the State Theater in downtown Olympia, WA. Makaela Milburn will direct.

A modern-day Sherlock Holmes and Dr. Watson emerge from the pandemic fog, solving mysteries and kicking butts, until they come face to face with a villain who seems to have all the answers.

A fast-paced romp that re-examines the classic adventure stories you love, through a bold new female lens.

Why this production to start Harlequin's 2025 "Hope and Heroes" season? First-time Harlequin director Makael Milburn says, "This show definitely fits the bill of a hero we know revealing a new side — Sherlock is an iconoclastic hero of the mind who we have seen interpreted in many ways and many cultures. Kate Hamill's version brings things into a right-now American way of sharing this story that has a lot of energy."

By imagining both Sherlock Holmes and Dr. Watson as female characters, playwright Kate Hamill shifts a few expectations that audiences may have of this classic duo. One of these is the turn on a "buddy" comedy. Says Milburn, "Similar to the turn taken on the cop-buddy movie in *The Heat*, this take lets us laugh at the trope AND understand it better. It makes space for revealing the anti-social brilliance of Sherlock, the incredible power of intuition, and the need for tangible connection with the world around us. In the end, it playfully reminds us that no matter who you are or what gifts you have, what gets people through are our friends."

Asked about the experience she hopes to deliver with the piece, Milburn says, "It is fastpaced femme farce fun! This play delivers a triple punch of a good mystery to solve, something beloved made new, and a great friendship formed. This night in the theater is the kind of warmth and silliness you need on a cold winter night."
